

# Casino Hold'em Poker – card game

## Rules of the Game:

### Overview

Texas Hold'em Poker is the world's most popular poker game. Casino Hold'em Poker uses the same concept as Texas Hold'em Poker, however it gives the player the opportunity to play against the casino.

### The Cards

Casino Hold'em is played with a standard pack of cards with 52 cards (Jokers are excluded). The individual cards are ranked in the following falling order: Ace (high or low), King, Queen, Jack, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2

### Optional bet (AA-Bonus)

Players have the opportunity to place a separate bet; "AA-Bonus". AA-Bonus winnings are paid when your hand contains a pair of aces or higher after the first three community cards are dealt (See: AA-Bonus Winnings Pay Table). Players must finish playing the first round in order to receive any AA-bonus winnings.

### Game Description

Players place bets on the "Ante", and optionally on the "AA-Bonus"

The dealer deals out 2 cards (face up) to each player and 2 cards (face down) to himself. In addition, 3 'community' cards are dealt face up in the middle of the table, this is called the 'Flop' and will eventually contain 5 cards.

Players now continue by either "Betting" or "Folding" If the player wishes to remain in the game, they place a bet on "Call" and the game continues ("Call" is always double the "Ante" amount). If the player chooses to "Fold" the player forfeits the round and the player loses all his bets as well as any possible "AA-Bonus" winnings.

If the player decides to continue ( "Bet" ), any possible "AA-Bonus" winnings will be paid out. If the player doesn't have an "AA-Bonus" winning hand, all "AA-Bonus" bets will be lost. The dealer deals an additional 2 community cards (called the "Turn" and "River") as well as shows his own hand.

To find a winner the dealer now compares his hand against the players'.

**The dealer must have a pair of 4s or higher to qualify.**

**If the dealer doesn't qualify:**

The player keeps his "Ante" and "Call" bet and wins with his "Ante" according to the "Ante Winnings Payout Table".

**If the dealer qualifies:**

If the dealer and the player have the same hand it is a "Push" and the player gets back his "Ante" and "Call" bet.

If the dealer has a better hand, the player loses all of his bets.

If the player has a better hand, the player keeps his "Ante" and "Call" bet and wins the "Ante" according to the "Ante Winnings Pay Table" and the "Call" which pays 1 to 1.

**Hands are counted in the following falling order:**

Royal Flush
Straight flush
4 of a kind
Full house
Flush
Straight
3 of a kind
2 pairs
Pair

**Results**

Dealer qualifies?	Hand	"Ante" Bet	"Call" bet

## Ante Winnings Payout Table

Hand	Pays
Royal Flush	100 to 1
Straight flush	20 to 1
4 of a kind	10 to 1
Full house	3 to 1
Flush	2 to 1
Straight or lower	1 to 1

## AA-Bonus Winnings Payout Table

Hand	Pays
Flush or higher	25 to 1
Pair of Aces to Straight	7 to 1

## Game Settings:

- You can open the game menu by clicking on the Key icon on the game panel.
- Sound – toggles sound effects on or off.
- Music – turns background music and sounds on or off.
- Game Speed – toggles the game proceedings from 1 to 4.

## Winning Percentage:

Winning Percentage (%) =  $(1 + (\text{Sum of Winnings} / \text{Sum of Bets Placed})) * 100$
